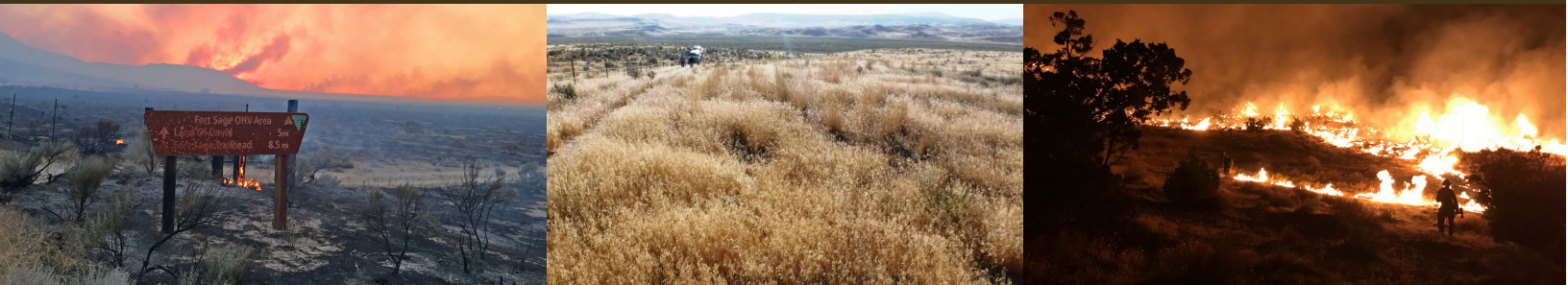


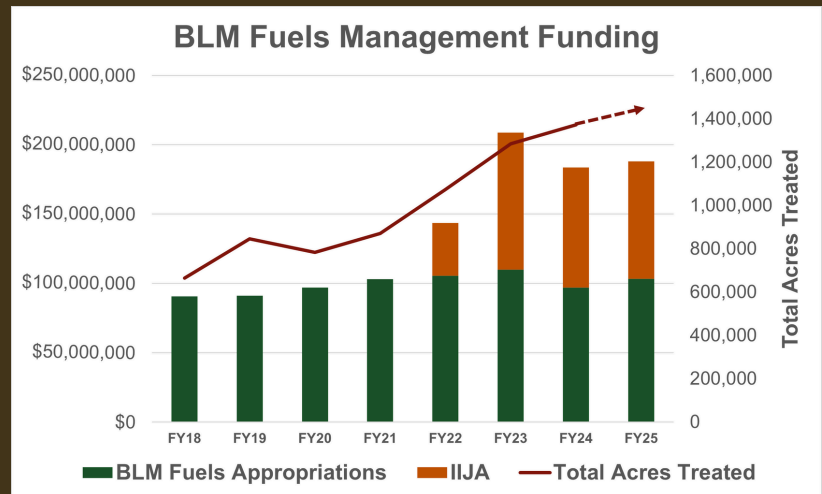
An Ounce of Prevention is Worth a Pound of Cure
