This model continues to find success and expand across the West! This work builds and promotes partnerships between federal agencies and permittees by promoting collaborative approaches to advancing livestock operation sustainability, production, and landscape health.

This is achieved through:

Bridged policy & storytelling: Ensured technical accuracy while still engaging.

Coordinated cross-agency efforts: Aligned messaging across teams within BLM.

Navigated evolving policy changes: Maintained clarity despite shifting priorities.

Increased internal engagement: Facilitated understanding and adoption of flexibility.

The IWJV produced a multi-year, multi-platform rollout of outreach materials aimed at improving internal awareness for BLM staff as well as external engagement by agricultural producers.
